# CONTRACT FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS STUDYING AT TAIERI COLLEGE

1. Taieri College agrees to accept the Student for education at the school upon the terms and conditions set out in this Contract.

Taieri College agrees to provide tuition in accordance with the New Zealand Ministry of Education Code of Practice for the recruitment, welfare and support of International Students <a href="https://www.minedu.govt.nz">www.minedu.govt.nz</a>

The student will be enrolled in a Year level based on information given in the application. This level is conditional on testing to check the level of English understanding.

The Year Level stated on the Offer of Place is not binding on the school.

There will be no refund of fees if a student transfers to another school, or if he/she is asked to leave because of misbehaviour or violation of the school contract.

Other applications must be made in writing to the school Principal

If a student is found to be not attending their course, the New Zealand Immigration Service will be notified. The visa may be revoked and the student may be required to return home.

- 2. The Student and Parent agree that the student shall obey the following Taieri College rules for International Students:
  - a) The student shall attend all classes each day, arrive on time and take part in all school activities that are timetabled for him/her.
    - All homework and assignments must be completed. If the student needs help, they must ask the teacher, ESOL> Dean or his/her homestay parents.
  - b) If the student is in a homestay and becomes sick and unable to go to school and/or attend classes, the school must be informed by the host parents.
  - c) The student should try to speak English in class, be courteous to teachers and participate in all classroom activities.
  - d) At no time is the student allowed to leave the school grounds without permission.
  - e) At no time is the student allowed to change his/her school or host family without permission from the school and his/her parents.
- 3. The Parent agrees that the adults caring for him/her shall be allowed to set such rules and conditions necessary for the care, safety and control of the student. In particular those rules and conditions shall include that he/she shall:
  - a) Ask permission of his/her host family before going out at night and agree on a reasonable and acceptable hour to be back home.

- b) During the weekends if he/she wishes to stay with a friend, permission needs to be granted from the host family.
- c) The telephone number and name of the person/persons he/she will stay with must be left with his/her homestay family so that he/she can be contacted if needed.
- d) International Students attending Taieri College **MUST** stay in a homestay situation under the care of a Homestay Manager. Students **WILL NOT** be permitted to live in a flatting situation.
- 4. At no time is the student allowed to buy a car or motorbike while in New Zealand nor to drive someone else's car.
  - **5.** Except in so far as it is provided for in this Contract, the legal responsibility and legal guardianship of the Student shall remain with the Parents. The Parents shall ultimately be responsible for important decisions for the student while he/she is in New Zealand.

The cost of travelling home shall be paid by the parents.

- 6. Circumstances under which Taieri College may terminate this contract are:
  - a) Non-disclosure of information
  - b) Imparting false information
  - c) Breach of student code of conduct, to include gross misconduct or continual disobedience.
  - d) Breach of New Zealand law.
