It was a real thrill to make it to the Nationals in Auckland and to see the high level of competition. There were ten mats with a constant flow of matches from 9.00am to 7.00pm in the evening. There were five-year-olds to fifty-five-year-olds giving it their all, representing clubs from all over the country, with hundreds of spectators cheering them on from the grandstands!

Casey fought in the under 80kg Division and placed second, earning a silver medal.

Cricket - McCullum Cup

Over the long weekend the 1st XI Cricket participated in the 20/20 McCullum Cup, Taieri College kicked off the weekend by playing John McGlashan College. John McGlashan won the toss and elected to bat, with regular wickets falling and some very tight bowling from Sam Duff who took one wicket and only went for six runs off his four overs. Taieri College restricted John McGlashan to 128 off 20 overs. The game was in the balance halfway through Taieri College's innings but a match winning partnership between Caleb Walker (32n.o) and Isaac Sinclair (42) saw Taieri College start the tournament with a good win.

In the second game of the day the boys played Waitaki Boys'. Waitaki won the toss and elected to bat. However, due to an uploading glitch we are yet to have the exact breakdowns. But Taieri College won the match chasing down the target of 140 in the 18th over.

Day Two saw Taieri College come up against Otago Boys' High School, Otago Boys' High School chose to bat first with Taieri College holding them to 136 off their 20 overs. All the Taieri College bowlers chipped in, taking regular wickets with both Caleb Walker and Max Shrimpton taking two wickets each. The Taieri College batting performance didn't really take off, with regular wickets falling, and not being able to get some key partnerships going. This saw the Taieri College team coming up short of the target they were chasing.

The last game saw Taieri College come up against St Kevin's in the third/fourth playoff game, St Kevin's were put into bat, Taieri took regular wickets but one of the St Kevin's batters held their innings together and got St Kevin's through to a handy total of 157. Joshua Walker took three wickets with Sam Duff claiming two wickets as well. Jalen Forgie was a safe pair of hands in the field pulling in two good catches. Taieri College got off to a shaky start losing two wickets for three runs. This brought Sam Duff to the crease who blasted the St Kevin's attack all over the park hitting five 4s and four 6s in his 56 off 24 balls. After an average start Taieri College were always chasing the game and in the end fell just short, being bowled out for 136.


