While subject choice at this stage of the year is not binding, the number of classes, and staff allocation, are based on this return, and therefore this should be filled in as accurately as possible. Any changes that are necessary after this intention sheet is returned can be made only with the approval of the Year 12 Dean. Students should bring a signed note requesting the change, and give it to their form teacher to pass on to the Dean.

In 2024 Year 12 students are required to do a Level 1 or Level 2 English course, and **five other** subjects.

Students are recommended to maintain a broad education. Most students stay on to Year 13 and must take care in choosing subjects that will fit into a future course.

There are specific requirements for entry to University and some other Tertiary courses. Check these out before course selection.

A booklet provided to all students contains information on all subjects available. Note that, in general, subjects only operate where there are sufficient students choosing that subject.
